**Message from the Director:**

2010 was the Library's best year yet! The Library was proud to be chosen the winner of the 2010 Rochester Regional Library Council (RRLC) Public Library of the Year Award. Patrons nominated our library as their favorite and commented on why they felt Chili Public Library was a special place. Two of their comments stand out, "The Library goes out of their way to serve all demographics from toddlers to seniors" and "The friendliest, most helpful staff of any library I have been in."

The Library was very busy in 2010 circulating **390,153** materials and welcoming **199,846** visits. Our 2010 Summer Reading Program (Make a Splash READ!) was the most successful ever with **782** children reading for a total of **261,084** minutes; **60** teens reading **326** books; and adults reading **2,451** books as part of the summer program.

Several new firsts also occurred in 2010. The library began buying eBooks for our OverDrive collection and we created a well-used Job Information Center. All of our accomplishments could not have been done without the support of our staff, library trustees, and volunteers.

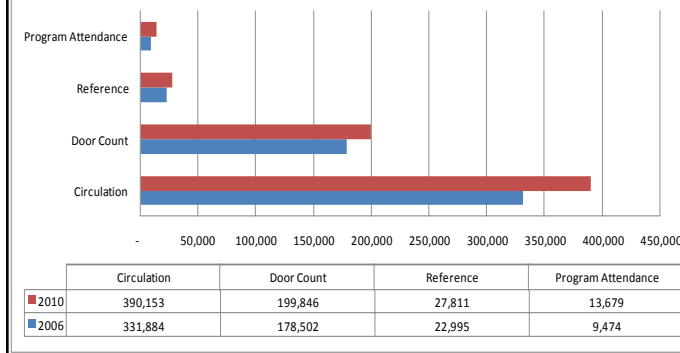
